Selection Criteria (100 Marks – Weighted Model)

1. Academic Results & Outcomes – 40%

- Board/University results (last 3 years)
- Pass percentage & distinction rates
- Topper performance (state/university ranks)

2. Consistency of Performance – 20%

- Year-on-year stability in results
- Improvement trends over time
- Low variance across batches

3. Competitive Exam Success – 15%

- Performance in JEE, NEET, Olympiads, etc.
- Number of qualified students
- Rank quality

4. Faculty Quality & Strength – 15%

- Qualifications (PhD, NET, B.Ed, etc.)
- Teaching experience
- Faculty retention & stability

5. Academic Systems & Student Support – 10%

- Mentorship programs
- Assessment & feedback systems
- Remedial classes / personalized learning support
